

## Mt. Greylock Road Race Details

The race start time is 8:30 AM

Registration and bib # pick up will start at 7:00 AM and end at 8:15 AM

Parking on both sides of Pattison Rd in front of the Mt. Williams Reservoir

There will be 4 port-a-potties at the race start.

Day of race fee is \$20.00

Timing chips should be attached to the outside of each leg with a safety pin on the outer most layer of clothing, please do not cover the chips. Bibs will be worn on the front where the number is easily read by the finish line timer. Timing chips should be turned in after the race at the finish line water stop into the pink baskets.

Water stops will be located approximately at mile 2.25 and mile 5.

There are only 3 turns of concern and 2 are self-evident. At the end of Notch road you can go right or left, left goes downhill, the wrong way, so turn right into the State Reservation and continue uphill. At about mile 7 there is a fork and you can go right or left, right goes downhill onto Rockwell road, that's the wrong way, turn left and continue uphill to the summit. The last direction is the one that people sometimes mess up. There is a small ring loop at the summit for cars to enter the summit and exit the summit. At this final ring loop about .1 miles from the finish the runners need to stay to the far right side of the road. You are running the same direction as the traffic and will finish on the right side of the road just past Bascomb Lodge.

Runners are responsible for their own transportation down the mountain.

Cars can be dropped off at the top prior to the race; however there are only 70 spots at the summit so everyone is encouraged to car pool, if you see someone going to drive up ask if you can get a ride down with them.

Parking is free at the summit as long as you are parked before 9 am; anyone parking at the summit after 9 am will be charged a parking fee (\$5 I think).

**THE ROAD IS NOT CLOSED TO TRAFFIC SO BE CAREFUL.**

Please tell any spectators to not follow the race up the mountain, they can pick 1 spot to watch from as not to ruin the race for other competitors.

No writing on the roads with any type of paint, chalk, etc. Yes this actually happened one year and you can still see it!
